Crossman to manage Winter Springs Town Center

Crossman & Co. on Thursday announced it has been selected to lease and manage the Winter Springs Town Center.

The 215,580-square-foot retail-and-restaurants project, being developed by Charleston, S.C.-based James Doran Co., currently has about 141,000 square feet open with tenants including Publix, **Barnie's**, Great Clips, **H&R Block**, **State Farm**, **Subway** and the **UPS Store**, according to a news release.

The center, at State Road 434 and Tuskawilla Road, is part of a 400-acre master-planned community in Winter Springs.

Crossman & Co., the largest third-party retail leasing and management company in Central Florida, oversees a real estate portfolio of about 5 million square feet valued at \$1 billion.
